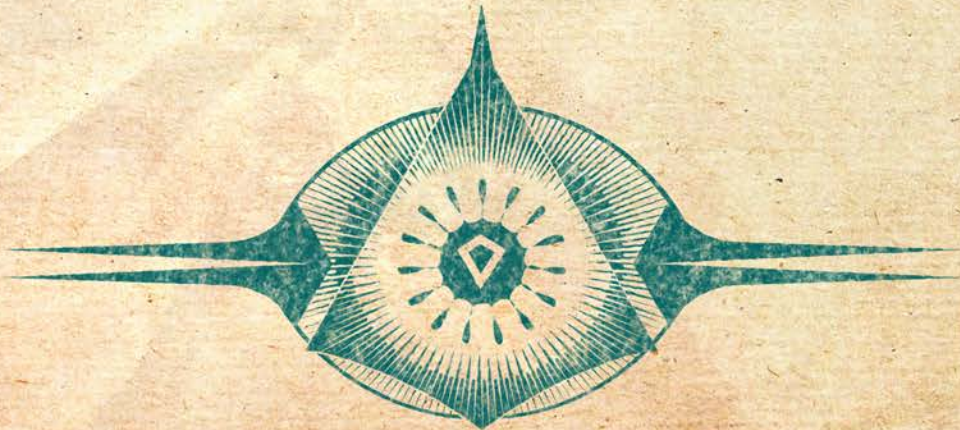

Perpetual motion???

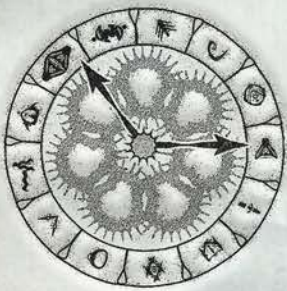
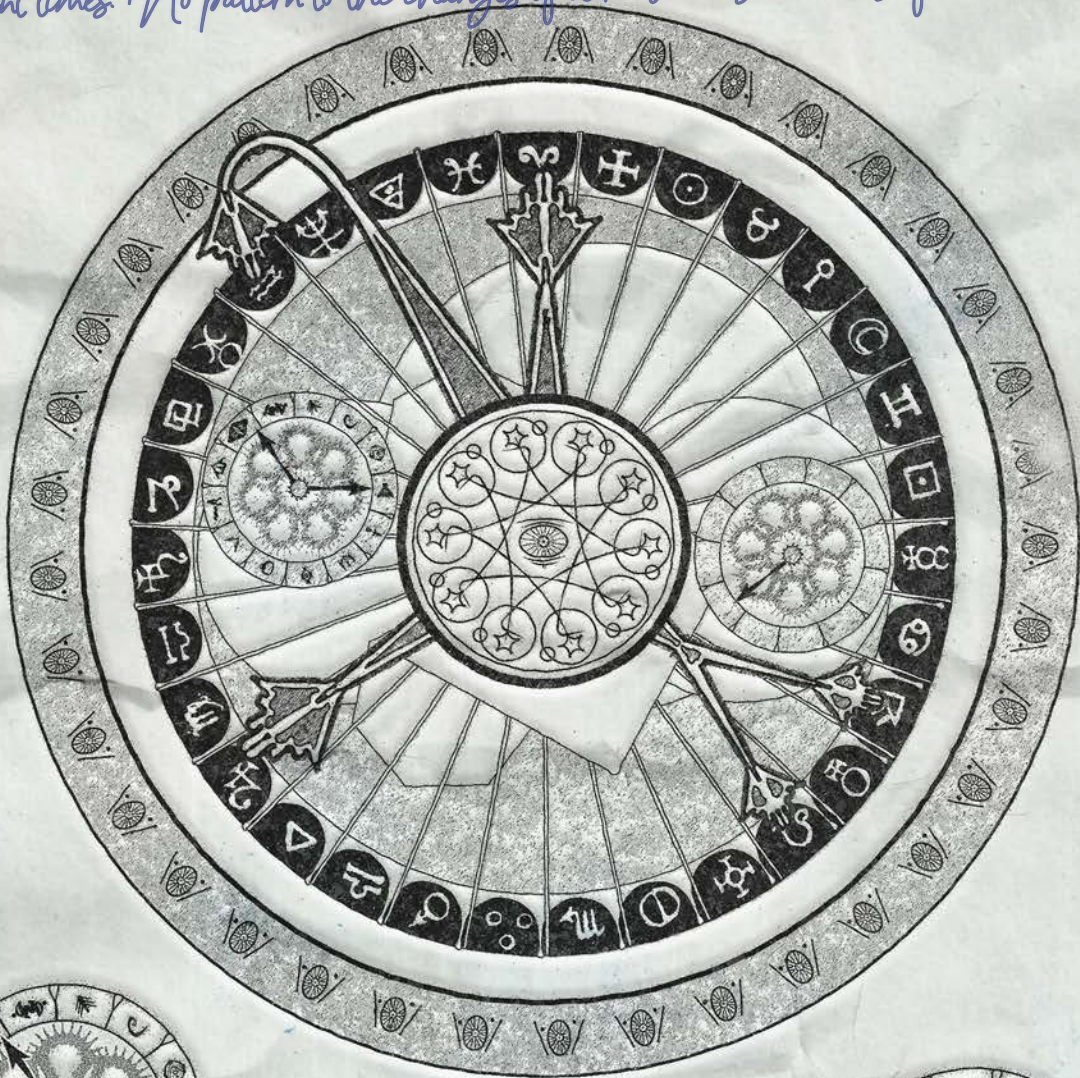

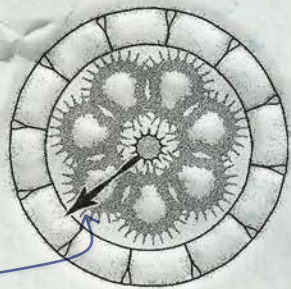
## ANOMALY REPORT CONTINUED

Astronomical and astrological symbols. Do the hands indicate celestial alignments? Each hand moves both clockwise and counterclockwise at different times. No pattern to the changes of direction discerned, as of now.



The hands have not moved since the object's discovery.

The hand has moved slightly counterclockwise over the course of a week. The speed suggests the divisions are months.



Does that make the other face an indicator of a year?

Counting down to an event? If so, a trigger?
