

RULES FOR FINDING DIGITAL PHOTOS

✓ You may:

- Use your photo app's **search bar** to find pictures.
- **Zoom in** on your photo before showing it. (Don't zoom out once everyone has seen it.)
- Use a **video**, but you must pause it on one frame before showing it.
- Show a **meme**, as long as it's already saved in your photo library.

✗ You may not:

- **Edit** a photo before showing it.
- **Search online** for new photos.
- Use **image-generation tools** to create new images.

FLEXIBLE MODE

Flexible Mode makes the game easier for anyone who has trouble finding photos for their prompt. You can use it for the whole group or just for some players.

Here's how it works:

1. At the start of the game, each player using Flexible Mode takes one Number Card of each type (1, 2, 3, and 4).
2. When a round begins, those players **choose** which prompt they want to use from their Prompt Card.
3. They place the matching Number Card face down in front of them before the timer starts.
4. Everyone else plays normally and **draws a random Number Card**.

OBJECT OF THE GAME

In Photo Dump, players use their digital photo libraries to give clues to assigned prompts and then work together to guess each clue correctly.

TIP: Don't have digital photos? No problem! You can play with printed pictures too, such as a photo album or a stack of old family photos.

SETUP

1. Shuffle the Prompt Cards.

Use the chart to see how many to use based on your player count. Place those cards face down in a draw pile. Put the rest back in the box—you won't use them this game.



# of Players	Prompt Cards
2, 4, or 8	16
3 or 5	15
6	18
7	14

2. Shuffle all the Number Cards.

Place them face down in a separate draw pile.



3. Set a 2-minute timer.

TIP: Turn up your phone's brightness and turn on auto-rotate so your photos flip between portrait and landscape automatically.

HOW TO PLAY

Photo Dump is played in rounds. Follow these steps each round:

1. Get your cards.

Everyone takes **1 Prompt Card** and **1 Number Card** from the draw piles.

- Place your Prompt Card face up in front of you.
- Look at your Number Card, this tells you which prompt to use on your Prompt Card. (Keep this card secret!)

2. Start the 2-minute timer.

3. Find your photo.

Everyone searches their photo library at the same time for one picture that fits their prompt (See *Rules for Finding Digital Photos* on page 4). When the timer runs out, choose your final photo. (You can decide together how strict to be about the time limit.)



4. Give clues and guess.

Pick one player to start as the **Clue Giver**. The Clue Giver shows the photo they picked.

- The rest of the group discusses which prompt they think the photo matches. The Clue Giver can't give hints—no talking or gestures!
- The group guesses, and the Clue Giver reveals their Number Card. If the guess is:

Correct, place that Prompt Card face up in the score pile.

Incorrect, place it face down instead.

END OF THE ROUND

When everyone has taken a turn as the Clue Giver, the round ends.

- Collect all Number Cards and shuffle them back into their draw pile.
- If there are still Prompt Cards left in the draw pile, prepare for the next round.

Then start again—follow the same steps as before!

END OF THE GAME

When the **Prompt Card draw pile** is empty, the game ends. Count the number of **face-down cards** (incorrect guesses) in the score pile. Use the chart below to see your final rating!

Incorrect Cards	Rating
0	<i>Picture Perfect! Total keeper.</i>
1	<i>Incredible! Definitely shareable.</i>
2–3	<i>Amazing! Good enough for the 'gram.</i>
4–5	<i>Nice shot! Maybe add a filter.</i>
6–7	<i>A bit blurry. Better luck next time!</i>
8+	<i>Whoops! Clean your lens and try again.</i>
