The Tale of the Sea Spray

THEY MEET

- ▶ The time has come for the finch to migrate 0. If it joins the other birds, their arrangement forms a "V" shape.

Take card V.



- ▶ The carp P, will leave when the bell gives the signal. The clocktower bell will next ring at 6 o'clock.

Take card 6.



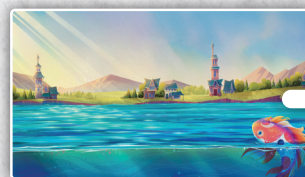
- ▶ As the two animals travel along the river V and 6, their gazes are connected by the current's lines. By positioning the cards so that the lines formed by the river's currents link the fish's eyes to the bird's eyes, the number 52 becomes visible in the current.

Take card 52.



- ▶ The carp, filled with emotion, leaps out of the water but loses sight of the finch. Access Machine 20 and select the direction in which the fish must swim to find the bird. Within the reflections seen on the water droplets 52, the bird can be seen near a tree and a house, where the house is next to a tower. Only one heading fits this description. Select the corresponding view and press OK.

Take card 41.



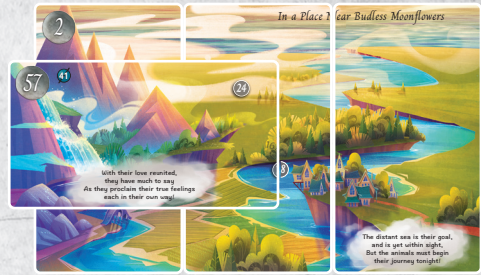
- ▶ The finch is also looking for its love 41, but there are so many carp that it struggles to locate the right one. Among all the fish, only one fish looks exactly like that found on the back of the cards, and it is labeled with +16C: $41 + 16 = 57$

Take card 57.



THE SEDUCTION

- ▶ The finch and the carp have found each other and can now declare their love. Place card **57** on top of the cards depicting the initial scenery to update the image.



- ▶ The carp shows its love by swimming from bubble to bubble.

Access Machine **78** and guide the fish toward each bubble as seen on cards **4** and **78** while avoiding obstacles (such as seaweed and coral) displayed on your screen. When you've reached the final bubble, the view will zoom out and you'll see the bubble trail forms a **+53**.



- ▶ The finch **24** is searching for a large hidden tree in the forest. The number 16 is hidden within the forest on card **57**. Take card **16**.



- ▶ Once it has found the tree (**16**), the finch (**24**) engraves a message of love into the bark. $16 + 24 = 40$. Take card **40**.



- ▶ The bird engraves its feelings into the tree **40**, but something is missing. To look from above, rotate the card 180° to read $1 + 8 = 9$. Take card **9**.



- ▶ Access Machine 85 The displayed text informs you that the sun and birds sink behind the sea 85 Gently slide card 85 behind the sea depicted on the scenery found on the adventure's initial cards. As you do this, the birds will indicate several letters, individually and in groups. In order, these are P, R, ESS, and MOON, which together form the message "Press Moon." As instructed, press the moon icon visible in the app's menu.



- ▶ As night falls, the lovers have once again gotten lost; you can find them on card 44. Scan this card with your device.



- ▶ The carp and the finch, caught between the sky and the sea, are searching for each other, but they each need an object to guide them. Assemble cards 44, 96, 97, 98 and 99 on your device's screen, then tap the white, feathery heart to reveal the bird's path. Next, press and hold the bird on the screen to guide it along the yellow path to its destination, which is the flower. In a similar manner, tap the orange heart-shaped fin to make its path visible. Hold your finger against the fish on the screen as you move it toward the hell. Finally, press the central heart to display new yellow and blue paths. Move both the bird and the fish simultaneously so that they reach the heart at the same time.
